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Gainesville Lady Bulldogs take third at Sparta tournament

Shayla Wages scores 1,000th point

The Gainesville Lady Bulldogs brought home third place at the Sparta Invitational Tournament held last week.

Bulldog fans had an exciting game to watch when the number 4 seed Gainesville girls took on number 5 Bradleyville Thursday, Jan. 7, and squeaked by with a 57-54 win.

Shayla Wages led with 22 points, followed by Hallee Donley with 17, and Elizabeth Kinworthy and Erin McKinzie with 8 each. Debra Winrod led in rebounds with 6. Wages led in assists with 4 and steals with 6.

The Lady Bulldogs returned on Friday to take on first seed tournament host Sparta, which now holds a 10-1 record. The Lady Trojans took a 69-17 win, holding all Gainesville scorers to single digits.

Players scoring for Gainesville were Wages 7, Donley 4, McKinzie, Laney Suter and Emory Warden 2 each.

Saturday's third place game was a thriller right down to the final buzzer when Hallee Donley's post shot sealed a 41-40 victory for the Lady Bulldogs.

Wages, who scored her 1000th point during the tournament, led the scoring with 20 points, followed by Kinworthy with 10. Debra Winrd led in rebounds with 9, followed by Kinworthy 7.

"The Sparta tournament was a good test for us," said coach Lance West. "We played three good competitive teams. We still have about 12 games left on the season, but I am pleased with the team's progress so far."

Gainesville's varsity record moves to 8-6 on the year and Gainesville's JV record is 1-2 on the season. The Lady Bulldogs are back in action on Thursday at home against Dora.

At Monday night's game against Bakersfield, GHS coach Lance West presented Shayla with a plaque and a ball commemorating her achievement. Gainesville's JV won 26-15, and Gainesville's varsity won 56-41.

GHS Bulldogs lose one, win one

The Gainesville Bulldogs were on the road last week, taking on the Thayer Bobcats on Tuesday, Jan. 5, and the Conway Bears on Friday, Jan. 8.

"We competed well and gave really good effort," Gainesville head coach Morris Jenkins said after the 57-42 loss to Thayer. "We had some key turnovers during their second-quarter run that we never quite recovered from. A definite positive seems to be that we play well enough to keep us competitive. I'm confident these guys will keep trying and improving as we progress through the season."

Bryce Hambelton and Jake Leeker led the scoring with 21 and 17 points, respectively. Hambelton and Landry Jenkins led in rebounds with 6 each. Jenkins led in assists with 4, followed by Wyatt Alms and Jake Leeker with 3 each.

Gainesville's junior varsity brought home a 47-34 winter over the junior Bobcats. Andrew Hambelton led the scoring with 14 points, followed by Sean Wallace with 10 and Nathan Kiger with 6. Other players scoring were Camden Evans 3 and Jarrett Hogan and Garrett Taber with 2 each.

Friday, the varsity Bulldogs pulled out a 52-45 win over the Conway Bears. "It

was good to get a conference win on the road," said Jenkins. "We have been struggling a bit with offensive consistency and had a little bit of the same in this game, but we did put up 20 points in the fourth quarter, which was encouraging. Our defense gave another good team effort."

Three players were in the double digits: Bryce Hambelton scored 15, Jake Leeker added 12 and Landry Jenkins scored 11. Other players scoring were Wyatt Alms with 7, Easton McGee 3, Carter Wise 2 and Ryan Poe 2. Hambelton led the

rebounding column with 12, followed by Leeker with 8. Leeker led in assists with 5.

Gainesville's JV dropped a 53-43 loss to the Bears. Andrew Hambelton led the Bulldogs' scoring efforts with 12 points, followed by Jarrett Hogan and Garrett Taber with 6 each and Camden Evans and Nathan Kiger with 5 each.

Gainesville varsity and JV traveled to Sparta to take on the Trojans on Tuesday, Jan. 12. They head to Dora to take on Ozark County rival Dora Falcons on Friday, Jan. 15. Games start at 6 p.m.

Dora Lady Falcons add two wins, bring season record to 9-5

The Dora Lady Falcons basketball team hosted Chadwick (7-2) on Monday, Jan. 4, and pulled out a thrilling 42-41 victory over the Cardinals. "We came out really strong to start the game," said Dora coach Cole Garnette. "We were hoping to start off strong and be able to push them the whole game and take away some of the things they do defensively. The girls played hard all night and executed our game plan extremely well."

Riley Collins led the scoring with 18 points for the Lady Falcons, followed by Cassidy Hambelton with 10 and Chesney Luna with 9. McKenna Miller added 4 and Lauren Martin chipped in 1. Collin Miller and Luna led the rebounding column with 5 each. Cassidy Hambelton led in assists with 5.

"Chadwick is a good team, and they didn't let us just run away with it," added Garnette. "They fought back and made it a game and made us work for every point at the end. Cassidy Hambleton is having a good year and is really trusting her teammates more than she has in years past, and it is showing. Riley Collins is stepping up her senior year and performing at a high level as well."

The Lady Falcons chalked up another win when they traveled to Mountain Grove and

defeated the Lady Panthers 46-38 Thursday, Jan. 7, bringing their record to 9-5.

Cassidy Hambelton had a great game, scoring 29 points for the Lady Falcons. Riley Collins added 11, and McKenna Miller scored 6. Hambelton and Collins led in rebounds with 5 and 4, respectively. Hambelton also led in steals with 10 and assists with 4.

"We came out a little slow to start the game but eventually had a 10-point lead in the second quarter," Garnette added. "To Mountain Grove's credit, they didn't lie down. They fought back and made it a 2-point game going into halftime, and I think they even led us by a point at the end of the third quarter. We found a way to win, though. We have been down several games late in the game, and I keep telling the girls that good teams find a way to win. Fortunately, the girls are doing just that. Even if our games may be close and stressful for their old coach; they are finding ways to win."

Dora hosted Couch Monday, Jan. 11. On Thursday, the Lady Falcons travel south to take on Gainesville's Lady Bulldogs at 6 p.m., and on Monday, Jan. 18, Dora hosts Hartville (11-4), with the girls' game beginning at 7:30 p.m., following the boys' game.
