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OCSD says scammers are using local phone numbers to trick Ozark County residents

The Ozark County Sheriff's Department says area scammers are at it again. OCSD says this time, scammers are "spoofing" local phone numbers, meaning the calls look as if they are originating from an Ozark County number.

Two specific scams have been reported by local residents. In one, the scammers claim they are with the IRS and attempt to get personal information over the phone. In another scam, the person on the other end of the line says a warrant has been issued for the resident's arrest.

The OCSD warns residents not to give out any personal information in either instance and to call the sheriff's dispatch office at 417-679-4633 to report the call.

Man arrested on \$10k bond, later released on his own recognizance

Donnie Brown, a 35-year-old Ava man who had an active Ozark County warrant issued last August, was arrested Jan. 21 during a traffic stop in Douglas County.

Brown, who is charged with abuse of a child, was arrested on a warrant with a \$10,000 cash-only bond.

After his arrest, he was transported to the Ozark County Jail and appeared before Associate Circuit Judge Raymond Gross on Jan. 26. He was arraigned, given a copy of the complaint against him and informed of his right to counsel and his right to remain silent.

Public defender Lauren Kate Welborn, who entered her appearance as Brown's attorney, filed a motion for discovery in the case and asked for a bond-reduction hearing, which was set for two days later.

Brown appeared before Gross again with Welborn as his attorney and was released on his own recognizance. A criminal setting is scheduled for 9 a.m. Tuesday, Feb. 9.

The case involves allegations that, as a form of punishment, Brown tied a 7-year-old child to a chair and hit the child with a belt, bruising the child.

The class D felony charge of abuse of a child carries a sentence of up to four years in prison.

Brown also faces a two charges of non-support of a child in Christian County.

Gainesville man charged with felony after allegedly stabbing brother in forehead

Ivan Mulero, 48, of Gainesville, was arrested Thursday, Jan. 28, and is being held in the Ozark County Jail on a \$2,500 cash-only bond in connection with a felony domestic assault charge stemming from a Jan. 27 incident in which he is alleged to have stabbed his brother in the face. Mulero could face up to four years in prison if convicted of the class D felony.

According to the probable cause statement in the case filed by Ozark County Sheriff's Deputy Justin Brown, the officer was dispatched to a home on County Road 615 near the Missouri - Arkansas state line off Highway 5 south, where a man had reportedly been stabbed.

Brown wrote in his report that he met with the victim, who had a laceration on his forehead just inside his hairline, along with a scratch and a "knot" on the right side of his head.

When the officer asked the victim how he sustained the injuries, the man reportedly told him that his brother, Mulero, had grabbed a kitchen knife and swung it at him, striking him in the forehead, causing the cut. He said Mulero then pushed him out the front door, which caused him to fall to the ground and hit his head.

Mulero was inside the residence, and when the officer asked him what had happened, he said he pushed his brother out the front door, and he fell onto the porch.

Call of domestic assault leads to meth charges

Gainesville resident Sharon Ashmead, 54, charged with possession of methamphetamine, is scheduled to appear for a bond-reduction hearing Tuesday, Feb. 9, before Associate Circuit Judge Raymond Gross.

According to the probable cause statement in the case filed by Ozark County Sheriff's Deputy Seth Miller, the Ozark County Sheriff's dispatch office received a call at 9:39 p.m. Tuesday, Jan. 19, reporting an active physical domestic abuse situation at a home on County Road 819 in Isabella.

After dispatch call, a fleeing suspect

The caller told the dispatcher that a woman would be fleeing the scene in a black pickup. Miller took the call and responded to the address given by the caller.

"I arrived at County Road 819 and observed a black S-10 leaving the scene.... I activated my emergency lights and siren, [and] the driver of the vehicle reversed down the county road," Miller wrote in his report. "I exited my vehicle and instructed the driver to exit the vehicle."

Miller says he saw that the driver was Ashmead, a suspect who he knew had several active warrants out for her arrest. Ashmead complied, and Miller placed her in handcuffs. When asked why she attempted to flee the scene, Ashmead told the officer that she was scared, the report says.

and other personal belongings.

During the vehicle search, Miller found a small cylindrical container on a key ring that held several small plastic bags filled with a white crystalline substance. Schofield also found a glass smoking device with white powder when she was patting down Ashmead, the report says.

Schofield placed the woman in her patrol vehicle and transported her back to the Ozark County Sheriff's Department, where an official inventory of the vehicle turned up straws covered in a white powdery substance, multiple glass smoking devices, Narcan nasal spray and three syringes. The items were photographed and placed into evidence.

After a field-test of the white crystal substance revealed that it was methamphetamine, it was placed into evidence and will undergo further analysis at the Missouri State Highway Patrol crime lab.

Criminal history

Information about the original domestic disturbance call was not available at press time.

Online records show that Ashmead has another Ozark County open case in which she is charged with possession of a controlled substance. That case was filed in July 2020.

Locally she's also pleaded guilty to excessive blood alcohol content, driving while intoxicated and operating a vehicle on a roadway with a revoked license in 2005, passing bad checks in 2008, driving while intoxicated with alcohol, charged as a persistent offender in 2009 and driving with a revoked or suspended license in 2020.

Methamphetamine and paraphernalia

Ozark County Deputy Cecilia Schofield, also on scene, led Ashmead to the front of the patrol vehicle and patted down the woman, searching for weapons.

Miller reportedly asked Ashmead if there was anything in the vehicle and if he could search her truck. She reportedly agreed and told the officer that there wasn't anything in the vehicle besides her clothes

OCHD continues to provide WIC services

The Ozark County Health Department has a signed contract with the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services and Region G WIC Group to continue to provide WIC services for federal/fiscal year 2021.

WIC is a nutrition education/health promotion program designed to help moms and young children eat well and stay healthy. The program provides nutrition information, promotes health and provides nutritious foods to supplement participants' diet.

WIC food packages may include milk, cheese, evaporated milk, cereal, juice, eggs, peanut butter, beans, fresh or frozen vegetables and fruits, and bread, tortillas or brown rice. Infants receive baby cereal and jars of baby food, as well as formula, if needed. Tuna is also provided to breastfeeding moms.

WIC is distributed by appointment only. Anyone interested in participating in this program should call OCHD at 417-679-3334 for an appointment. An OCHD spokesperson said the health department is proud to be associated with WIC and recognizes the program's contribution in making Ozark County a healthier place to live.

Income requirements apply; guidelines are based on 185 percent of the poverty level. For more information, contact OCHD. Federal law and U.S. Department of Agriculture regulations prohibit discrimination of WIC participants.
